#### **School Council Meeting Minutes:**

### 1. Welcome

- Meeting called to order by JP Grebenc at 7:04 pm
- Attendees introduced themselves, including number of children enrolled and corresponding grade level

#### 2. Overview of Tasks/Appointment of Council Positions

- JP nominated himself to continue with position of President of Parent Council; all were in favor and motion was carried
- Cheryl Popik volunteered for position of Vice President; JP moved to appoint, all were in favor and motion was carried
- Jackie Anderson offered to continue as Secretary of the council; JP motioned, all were in favor and motion was carried

## 3. Chair Report (JP Grebenc)

- The first COSC meeting of the 2017/2018 school year will be held October 4<sup>th</sup>, so no news to share yet with the council

#### 4. School Trustee Report (Skip Gordon)

- The building of the Ardrossan replacement school is on time and currently on budget; students still expected to be moved in over the winter break
- The new parking lot of the replacement school will be delayed until Spring when the weather will permit the pouring of new asphalt
- There are currently 17, 100 students enrolled in Elk Island Public school district
- School Board elections taking place October 16, 2017
- The new classroom is in place, utilizing half of the school library due to the growing student population at Ardrossan Elementary
- School board is considering the 2018/2019 calendar and is considering parent input as to
  whether students should return to classes from summer holidays prior to Labour Day and
  continue with a fall break OR if they should return to classes following the Labour Day long
  weekend and remove the fall break. A quick show of hands provided a near 50-50 split
  decision from parents in attendance
- There is a proposed name change for the replacement school to reduce the current "wordy" name of École Élémentaire Ardrossan Elementary School to a more simplified "Ardrossan Elementary". Council members and parents discussed how this potentially reduces the ability to distinguish the francophone side of our school and takes away its uniqueness. The

group proposed the idea of presenting the name "École Ardrossan Elementary" instead to the board in order to keep an element of francophone awareness within the name of the school

### 5. Administration Report (Judy Whetstone & Helene Hewitt)

- To begin, a couple of thank-yous:
  - 1. Thank-you to the CPF and dedicated volunteers for a tremendous event at last June's year-end BBQ
  - 2. Thank-you to parents who heeded the plea to send their children on the bus at the start of the school year due to VERY reduced parking
- The start of the school year began with a hitch due to drainage issues; the high school was a huge help in assisting with washroom facilities and student supervision
- The Grade 1 students hosted the first assembly of the year, introducing Habit 1 of the 7 Habits (Be Proactive!)
- Week 2 of the new school year brought a visit from Elder Wilson
